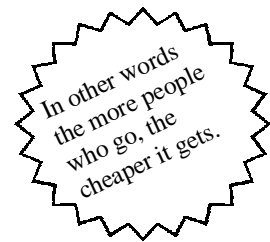

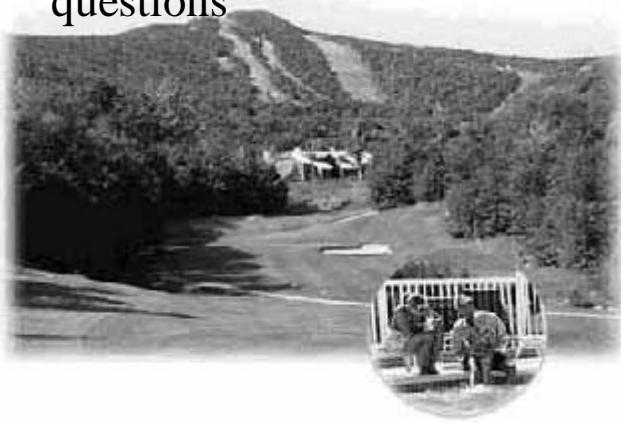

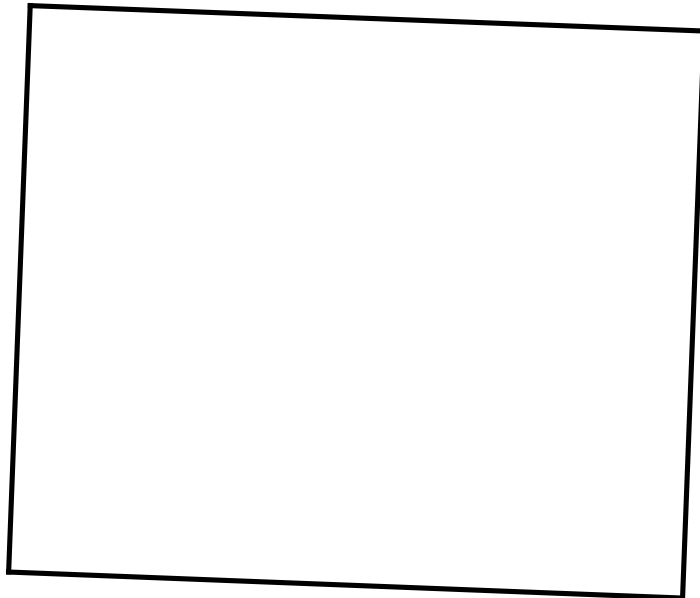
members who have told me that I do well when I give them out.
